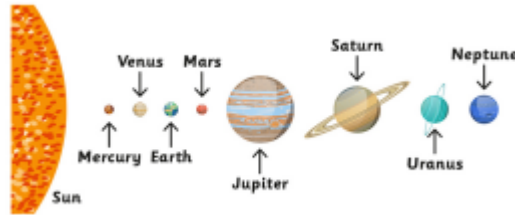


Year 1 Learning Log
