*We received a lovely email from somebody in the community- 'I just wanted to contact you to tell you about the amazing job some of your children have done this weekend. Many children at St Joseph's play football at Seedfield JFC. During the week members of the travelling community moved onto their site. When they left on Thursday they damaged the pitches and broke into the containers taking all of the equipment. Over £20,000 worth of equipment was taken including goalposts, nets, balls, line marking equipment and lawn mowers. This weekend the children from Seedfield have represented the club at Tesco in Bury and taken part in bag packing and a bucket collection. The community champion at Tesco and some of the customers described the children as well behaved and polite. I spent time with the children on both days and they did an absolutely incredible job and managed to raise an amazing amount of money towards the rebuilding costs. I thought it was good for you to know what great work your children do not just in school, but out of school too!'*
