

at home!




Over the coming weeks, EYFS we will be talking lots, learning more and participating in the events below.

<p>Build a hide [indoors or out]</p> <p>Bird watch one day</p> <p>Count/tally the number of birds you see</p> <p>Take photos of birds</p> <p>Feed the birds</p> <p>Make a bird feeder</p> <p>Choose a bird and find out/research all about it</p> <p>Paint/draw/make your own bird (2D or 3D)</p> <p>Sing "Two Little Dicky Birds" with actions</p>	<p>Find out which animal in the Chinese calendar represents the year you were born in</p> <p>Try/cook Chinese food Can you use chopsticks?</p> <p>Cook noodles/spagetti and put in a bowl to play with</p> <p>Paint/draw/make your own tiger (2D or 3D)</p> <p>Dance and move to Chinese music or join in a Chinese dragon dance</p> <p>Watch and talk about Cbeebies: Preparing for Chinese New Year - Let's Celebrate</p>	<p>Spot numbers outdoors in all different places</p> <p>Go on a number hunt around your house [order some numbers you find]</p> <p>Go shopping and help to buy/pay for something (low value) using coins</p> <p>What number can you count aloud to starting at zero? Can you now count back to zero from this number? Keep practising to see how far you can get to!</p> <p>Choose different items and count how many you have in total in your home. Eg. How many chairs do you have in your house?</p> <p>Play board games using a dice or countign games</p>	<p>Go on a Winter walk, choosing what to wear for yourself and looking out for signs of Winter</p> <p>Help take photos on your walk</p> <p>Talk about Winter and how it compares to another/other seasons</p> <p>Youtube and enjoy Winter related stories</p> <p>Create your own Winter scene</p> <p>Find out ... What do animals do in Winter to keep warm?</p>	<p>Look out for flowers</p> <p>Learn the names of some common flowers</p> <p>Paint/draw/make your own flower(s)</p> <p>Talk about the different parts of a flower - what are they called, what do they do?</p> <p>Help do some planting/gardening</p> <p>Visit/make a gallery</p> <p>Observational drawing of a flower or plant</p>	<p>Share and talk about story/ fiction books. Review each book: - what is the name of the book? [using the word <u>title</u>] - which part of the story did you like best? Why? - how many stars out of five would you give this book? Why? - who wrote the book? [using the word <u>author</u>]</p> <p>Share information/non-fiction books. Reflect on each book: - what was the book about? - what did you learn?</p> <p>Which is your favourite book and why?</p> <p>Visit local library</p> <p>Draw a picture from a favourite book</p> <p>Share pictures of you reading - where's the cosiest/funniest place you can read?</p> <p>On a plain t-shirt draw your favouite charater and wear on World Book Day if you wish</p>	<p>Go on a Spring walk, choosing what to wear for yourself and looking out for signs of Spring</p> <p>Help take photos on your walk</p> <p>Talk about Spring and how it compares to another/other seasons</p> <p>Plant your own seeds</p> <p>Draw/paint baby Spring animals</p> <p>Talk abot lifecycles of animals such as frog/chick</p>
