I like researching and planning:

Find out about a place in Mexico you would like to go to. Plan a 2 week holiday for you and your family. Find out the cost of flights, a hotel, excursions, meals out and transport to and from the airport then estimate how much spending money you will need for 2 weeks.

Make a table with the cost of each item and work out the total cost.

Extension: Minimum wage in the UK is £9.18. How many hours would you need to work to pay for your trip?

I like being artistic:

Find out about Frida Kahlo, one of Mexico's most famous artists. Draw, paint, use mixed media or create a digital image taking inspiration from her style of artwork.

Or you could design and build a Mayan Temple out of resources you have at home.

I like baking and cooking:

Find a recipe for a traditional and delicious Mexican food such as enchiladas, tacos or churros. Prepare a meal of your choice with an adult for your family to enjoy! (Or encourage your parents to treat you to Chiquitos and call it homework!)

Research some of the different myths, legends and Gods of the Ancient Maya.
