Research and search for pictures of Viking coins/money. Describe what they look like and compare them to the money we use today.

I like learning outside:

Find out if there are any Viking strongholds or settlements near where you live. Try to visit one with your family. Take lots of photographs of what you see.

Make your own Viking jewellery with using natural materials that you find outside. Take a photo of your jewellery.

Go on a walk in your local area. Can you see any examples of Viking influences?
