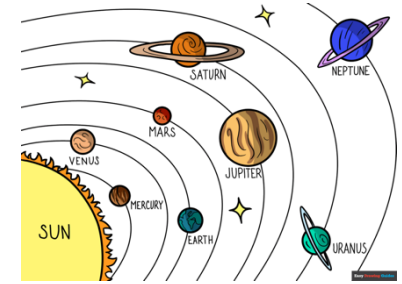


Year 5 Homework Grid
